Re: Mandatory Training on Child Abuse & Neglect

Wisconsin law requires all employees of Wisconsin public school districts to report suspected child abuse and neglect.¹ In addition, all employees are now required to receive training, provided by the Department of Public Instruction (DPI), on child abuse and neglect.²

To meet the training requirement, the DPI has created a webcast: *Mandatory Reporting of Child Maltreatment-Training for All School Employees*. All District employees are required to view the webcast in order to meet the training requirement.

At the end of the webcast, you may choose between 1) a dated completion certificate (must be forwarded to the HR Office) or 2) an email generated from the DPI and sent to human resources.
