Thank you for your patience and understanding during this unique time. All Whitefish Bay School District schools are closed until at least April 24, 2020, per Gov. Evers. Please, keep in mind that this unprecedented situation continues to change and we will do our best to keep families up to date with the latest information available through our Coronavirus webpage.

Our staff continues to spend time finalizing our Virtual Learning Time (VLT) implementation plan. **Daily VLT in WFB will begin Monday, April 13, 2020, at 8a.m.** As soon as April 1, students and families may begin to receive emails from their teachers with information, potential review and preview assignments, and learning expectations.
