

Algebra 1: Exam Review Steps for Success!!!

Step 1: Look through your binder and find review packets for the past major tests and quizzes. Re-work some of those problems to refresh your memory on what you have already learned this semester.

Step 2: Create a study guide. This review guide should include a specific list of concepts we have covered. You can generate the list by using the reviews mentioned above or by accessing the “Algebra Learning Targets” on the high school webpage:

Important formulas and example problems should be included to create a helpful review tool.

Step 3: Work the problems in the exam review packet. This packet is generally available about a week before the exam.

Step 4: Check your answers and create a list of questions. Be sure to bring those questions with you to in-class review days.

Step 5: ASK questions – during class or ISHP. You may also want to form a study group and ask a friend. It will be helpful to both you and your friend when you discuss your questions.

Step 6: Work additional problems. You should copy problems from the review packet, old homework assignments, or your textbook onto a blank sheet of paper and re-do them. Afterwards, check your accuracy.

Step 7: Get a good night sleep and eat a healthy breakfast and lunch.

Step 8: Be confident and do your best. Think positively!
