Dear Families,

This year our spelling program is a combination of words which integrate with the story selections in our reading anthology, words based on the same spelling pattern, and words misspelled in our daily writing.

We will start our practice spelling unit next week with our *No Excuse* words. These are words that have been identified by teachers and researchers to be high frequency, high use words that students are held accountable for correctly spelling in all of their writing.

Every Monday your child will bring home a list of spelling words to study for the week. On Friday, all students will be given a spelling test.

Throughout the week, the second graders will use our spelling activities and lessons for practicing their spelling words. Be creative in how you help your child practice at home!
