Dear Teacher,

The Whitefish Bay School District summer school will again offer **recommendation-only** classes in math and literacy for current kindergarten through seventh grade students. This letter is information for teachers who have students that reside in Whitefish Bay, but do NOT attend WFB schools.

We have worked with the reading and math coaches and interventionist to give guidance to teachers about who they should recommend for summer school. Please use this table below for **guidance** to identify students for the recommendation-only reading and math courses, along with your summative and formative classroom assessments. We know that some of our resident students who attend other local schools, may not have the same universal screening assessments listed below. If your school or classroom uses similar assessments, or if you are unsure, please consider what data you may have that demonstrates that your student is instructionally a grade level or below.

I have attached to this informational letter the **Whitefish Bay Summer School Recommendation Form** for literacy and math. Please make sure to fill out the attached form for the students that meet or closely meet the below guidelines and give it back to the recommended student's parents or guardians to submit with their registration information. We are unable to process their registration without the attached form. Don't ignore your "gut" feelings either, you are usually right, so recommend!
