

Tips for STUDYING for a Math test

1. Make a list of objectives that will be covered on the test. You can check the objectives from each section in your text, or access the learning targets online at:
<http://www.wfbschools.com/schools/high/MathLearningTargets.cfm>
2. Write down any new definitions or vocabulary and look over them several different times as the test approaches.
3. Find 2 problems similar to each objective. Copy them onto a blank sheet of paper and work them as though they were on a test.
4. Check your answers. If they are not all perfect, seek help during class, during ISHP or after school.
5. Work some more problems on the objectives that are giving you difficulty.
6. Try to anticipate what type of questions you will be asked.
7. Be confident and do your best.

The most important part of studying for a math test is actually doing problems. Just looking over a problem that is already done won't help you nearly as much as working out the problem again.
