The following information is being provided to assist parents to work cooperatively on behalf of an enjoyable and safe Sadie Hawkins.

#### SADIE HAWKINS FACTS

- \* Saturday, February 18, 2012 at the Harley-Davidson Museum(400 West Canal St)
- \* Dance is from 8:00 - 11:00 PM.
- \* Ample parking is available on-site. Directions from WFBHS: <http://tinyurl.com/ya83qc2>
- \* Attire is semi-formal.
- \* Only appropriate dancing will be permitted. Grinding, defined as the primary point of contact is below the waist, will not be allowed and repeat offenders will be removed from the dance floor.
- \* Parents of any students not arriving by 9:00 PM will be called immediately.
- \* Students leaving before 10:30 need parent permission.
- \* Guests from other high schools are allowed but a Guest Permission Form must be submitted by 3:30 PM on Friday, February 17. A form is included on the next page and forms are available in the Activities Office.
- \* All attendees must be in at least 9<sup>th</sup> grade. No one over the age of 19 may attend.
- \* Tickets will be on sale during lunch from Tuesday, February 14 until Friday, February 17. No tickets will be sold after 3:30 PM on Friday. No tickets will be sold at the door. Tickets cost \$15 per person.
- \* No person will be admitted to, or allowed to stay at Sadie's who is believed to be under the influence of alcohol or any other controlled substance. For that reason, High School officials may utilize a Breathalyzer if a student is suspected of being under the influence of alcoholic beverages. If a student refuses to be tested, they will be removed from the dance and will be referred to the Milwaukee Police Department.
- \* Students who violate school rules regarding the use of alcohol, tobacco or other controlled substances will face school consequences, including a 3 day out of school suspension, and will be referred to the Milwaukee Police Department.

All people associated with running this dance are looking forward to a safe and memorable 2012 Sadie Hawkins. Help us by making certain that you know your child's plans for the entire evening and that they are involved in safe and appropriate activities.
