Five students won prizes for their documentaries submitted in C-SPAN's national [2018 StudentCam](#) competition.

Will Foote and James Dyer received \$3,000 for their documentary "WI Votes Count?", which focuses on gerrymandering and the 14th Amendment Equal Protection Clause.

Fellow Whitefish Bay students **Patricia Mathu, Emma Mitchell and Jong Jung** were third-prize winners and received \$750 for their documentary "Neither Snow Nor Rain" about the Postal Clause.

At a ceremony today the students not only received their C-SPAN Certificates and checks but received a certificate of recognition from Senator Ron Johnson's office, a commemorative plaque from the Village of Whitefish Bay, and matching contribution checks from Spectrum Communications.
