Greetings Whitefish Bay School Community,

At the Wednesday, April 27th School Board Meeting, the Board voted to update the previous Masking Guidelines for our District schools.

Beginning Thursday, April 28th, masking guidance will be based on two criteria:

- [COVID-19 Community Level](#), which can be found on the CDC's website. When Milwaukee County Community Level is **High**, masks will be **required** in all District schools. The CDC Community Level will be evaluated weekly on Fridays.
- [Percentage of positive cases in the school](#), which can be found on the District COVID-19 Dashboard. When positive cases in a school reach **3% or more**, masks will be **required** in that specific school. The school positivity rate will be evaluated weekly on Fridays.

What does this mean?

As of tomorrow, Thursday, April 28th, masks will be **optional** in all district schools based on the metrics outlined above.

Please note that this communication is intentionally brief to disseminate information in a short timeframe. A follow-up communication will be sent to all district families and staff with more details on Thursday, April 28th with additional details and further clarification.
