#### 4 Year College Admissions

- English: 4 years
- Math: 3 years (4 years preferred).
- Science: 3 years (4 years preferred).
- Social Studies: 3 years
- World Language: Some colleges require 2 years; more selective colleges prefer 3 to 4 years.
