Summer 2024 Camp Counselor-In-Training (CIT) Program

The Counselor-In-Training Program is a work experience program designed for teens entering their **senior year** in high school in the year 2024. CITs will work with youth in a summer day camp environment to assist in the organization and implementation of camp activities. This is a paid, 25-hours-a-week, Monday - Friday (hours will vary between the hours of 7:30 am – 6:00 pm), summer work experience program. There are typically four CIT positions available and CITs must be able to commit to the full 8-weeks of Summer Camp from June 24th – August 16th.

Application Process:

CIT Application Packets may be picked up as soon as the Winter/Spring Whitefish Bay Recreation and Community Education Program Guides are distributed to the community and schools. Application packets can be found at the main office of the Whitefish Bay High School and the Whitefish Bay Recreation and Community Education Department.

Deadlines and Important Dates:

All application packets must be completed and returned to the WFB Recreation and Community Education Department no later than April 5, 2024. All candidates will be interviewed and if hired attend mandatory staff training the week of June 17th.
