Summer 2025 Camp Counselor-In-Training (CIT) Program

The Counselor-In-Training Program is a work experience program designed for teens entering their <u>senior</u> <u>year</u> of high school in the year 2025. CITs will work with youth in a summer day camp environment to assist in the organization and implementation of camp activities. This is a paid, 25-hours-a-week, Monday - Friday (hours will vary between the hours of 7:30 am – 5:30 pm), summer work experience program. There are typically four CIT positions available and CITs must be able to commit to the full 8 weeks of Summer Camp from June 23^{rd} – August 15^{th} .

Deadlines and Important Dates:

All application packets must be completed and returned to the WFB Recreation and Community Education Department no later than April 4, 2025. New applicants will be interviewed and if hired attend mandatory staff training the <u>week of June 16th</u>.
