



Grades 4 and 5 Richards School Geography Bee Round 1 - Online Assessment December 4th and 6th

Round 1 of the National Geographic Bee will take place during lunch/recess time on Tuesday, December 4th for Grade 4 and on Thursday, December 6th, Grade 5. Students interested in competing may sign up on the sheet posted in each classroom or see Mrs. Jones in person. Signatures from interested students will be accepted until the day of the competition. Mrs. Jones will collect those students who choose to compete on the day of the competition.

The competition includes a 35 question online assessment. This will be considered Round 1 of the School Geography Bee and will include questions about US Geography, State Quarters, US Cities, Continents, Physical Geography, Fresh Water, and Cultural Geography. All sections but the last are multiple choice. The portion on Cultural Geography contains 5 short answer questions. Top scoring students across both Grade 4 and Grade 5 will then compete in the School Geography Bee - Round 2 - scheduled for January 9, 2019.
