



K-12 Talent Development Identification Criteria (Updated - 10/2022)

At least three criteria are needed for identification in the category of giftedness. In intellectual identification a mandatory two objectives are needed: one in column A and one in column B. An added criteria in intellectual identification may come from a third criterion in either column A or B, or another related criterion.

In academic identification, there may be three criteria from the intellectual and academic list or two criteria from the intellectual and academic list and one from the specific academic criteria list. In the area of academic identification, the criteria needs to be within the same subject-specific area.
