

Parent Representatives Sought for District Calendar Committee

On March 16, 2016, as a part of the English language arts curriculum renewal and design process, the School Board approved a District Calendar committee recommendation. It stated, "Establish a District Calendar Study Team - Consistent time for teacher collaboration and planning are imperative for success in ALL areas and levels. The next District Calendar should reflect this need in its priority."

Charge to the Study Committee: The administration recommends the following charge be given to the District Calendar Committee:

- We are committed to the approved Focus Plan;
- Common and regularly structured collaboration, meeting, and planning time is essential for successful implementation of the Focus Plan goals;
- Gaining input from our teachers, recreation department, activities and athletics, 4K-12 parents, and community is important;
- Considering the impact on students, parents, community and staff is paramount;
- Opportunities for professional development in alignment with system priorities is essential;
- We are committed to continuous improvement AND opportunities for the Seven Thriving Dispositions.

Per School Board policy, interested parents/community members must apply to participate on District committees. Applications are reviewed by the Administrative Council. Parents/community representatives are selected based on the following criteria:

1. Training, interest, or experience in this area
2. Reasons for wanting to be on this committee
3. Ability to contribute to meeting the goals set forth in the committee's purpose

The time commitment for representatives will involve six - eight meetings. Typically, meetings are held from 3:45-5:15 p.m. at the High School, but there are some full day meetings scheduled during the 2016-2017 school year as well. Below are the dates for the upcoming school year:
