Clothing with alligators, rivers, beaches, lakes, turtles, etc. is encouraged. Blue or green also work!

### • Second Grade: Ancient People, Places, and Things

Clothing with dinosaurs, Earth, fossils, caves, bats, etc. is encouraged. Khaki or other "paleontologist-style" clothing certainly works, too.

## • Third Grade: Trails and Waterways

#### • Fourth Grade: Hawai'i Volcanoes National Park

Hawaiian shirts, board shorts, leis, flowers, wraps, etc. are encouraged, but remember that there are specific guidelines in the Richards Handbook for attire. Flip flops are not ideal for students to walk up and down steps safely.

### Fifth Grade: Shenandoah National Park
