The following information is being provided to assist parents in working cooperatively with the school to provide our students with an enjoyable and safe Homecoming.

## **HOMECOMING FACTS**

- \* Saturday, October 13, 2018 in the Great Hall at Richards Elementary.
- \*The dance will be from 7:30 until 10:30 PM.
- \* Attire is semi-formal.
- \*Only appropriate dancing will be permitted. Inappropriate dancing will be addressed and students not meeting appropriate dancing expectations will be removed from the dance.
- \* All students will check-in. ID cards must be presented with the ticket at the door.
- \* Parents will be notified if their child does not arrive at Homecoming by 8:30.
- \* No students will be allowed to leave the dance before 10:00 P.M. WFBHS students can bring a guest from another high school with a completed **Guest Permission Form** located in the Activities Office and on the activities website. This form must be submitted to the Activities Office by 3:30 PM on Thursday, October 11th.
- \* Tickets will be on sale during ISHP/Lunch starting on Monday, October 8th until Friday, October 12th. **No tickets will be sold at the door**. Tickets cost **\$15 per person**.
- \*\* No person will be admitted to, or allowed to stay at Homecoming who is believed to not be at absolute sobriety. For that reason, High School officials may utilize a Breathalyzer if a student is suspected of not being at absolute sobriety. If a student refuses to be tested, they will be removed from the dance and will be referred to the police.
- \* Students who violate school rules regarding the use of alcohol, tobacco, drugs or other controlled substances will face school consequences, including a 3 day out of school suspension, and will be referred to the police.

All people associated with running this dance are looking forward to a safe and memorable 2018 Homecoming. Help us by making certain that you know your child's plans for the entire evening and that they are involved in safe and appropriate activities.
