

Behavior Recognition/Ticket System

1. All staff carry tickets in lanyards and pass out tickets to students when students are demonstrating Cougar Pride in our common areas. The staff usually verbalizes what expectation is being met and how the student is being respectful, responsible, or safe.
2. Students are responsible for writing their first and last name and grade level and teacher initial on the ticket.
3. Students turn tickets into classroom containers
4. Every week, the classroom container is brought to the office and tickets are turned in for weekly drawings.
5. During Tuesday's end-of-the day announcements, 10 tickets are drawn and winners are announced over the PA system.
6. Winners go to Ms. Bradley's office to choose a Cougar Pride prize and their names are displayed on a poster in the office window for the week.
7. All collected tickets are dumped into a larger container just outside the office door. Our school-wide goal is to fill this container for a whole-school celebration :)
