LOCKERS AND LOCKS

Each student is assigned a hallway locker equipped with a combination lock for her/his personal school use. Lockers are also provided for Physical Education class use, but students must supply their own locks. **In order to prevent theft, it is imperative students securely store any valuable possessions they bring to school.**

MATERIALS NEEDED: New this year we have a more comprehensive list of required supplies for many core classes:

World language (all classes): 4 pack of low odor chisel point whiteboard markers, folder, notebook

English (all classes): Binder, binder dividers, post-it notes (3 pk), highlighters, 2-pocket folder, pens and pencils

Math: Pencils, additional erasers, highlighters, 3-ring binder, graphing calculator (TI-84 recommended), Notebook or loose-leaf paper

Social Studies: 3-ring binder & notebook/paper for each social studies class

Science:

Biology: 1 ½ - 2 in binder, 8 Dividers, correcting pen, highlighters (multiple colors), pens/pencils (multiple color), post-its: (1 pink, 1 blue, 2 yellow), 3x5 notecards, 12 pk colored pencils

Chemistry: 1 ½ - 2 in binder, Calculator (scientific or graphing), correcting pen, highlighters (multiple colors), pens/pencils (multiple color), post-its (3 packs), 3x5 notecards-1 pack, 12 pk colored pencils

Physics: 1 ½ - 2 in binder, Calculator (graphing preferred), correcting pen, highlighters (multiple colors), pens/pencils (multiple color), post-its (3 packs), notecards-1 pack

Computer Science: (Principles, AP Principles and JAVA): Composition notebook, 3x3 post-it notes (3 packages)

Physical Education: 1-inch binder and notebook, combination padlock
