DPI Mandatory Reporting of Threats of School Violence (Act 143)

All WFB employees:

Per Act 143 (passed in 2018), Wisconsin law requires all employees of Wisconsin public school districts to report to local law enforcement if the person believes in good faith, based on a threat made by an individual seen in the course of professional duties regarding violence in or targeted at a school, that there is a serious and imminent threat to the health or safety of a student or school employee or the public. Furthermore, every school district employee shall receive training regarding reporting of threats of violence within the first six months after commencing employment with the school district and at least once every five years after that initial training.
